EAGLES COMPLETE DIABETES RESEARCH CENTER COMMITMENT - \$25 MILLION - On Sunday, July 13, we presented the final \$6 million installment of our \$25 million commitment to fund the Fraternal Order of Eagles Diabetes Research Center at the University of Iowa, concluding a six-year fundraising campaign which will go down as the largest in the 116-year history of the organization.

The presentation was part of the Eagles' annual Welcome Show, which formally kicks off Convention, and took place inside Orlando's Rosen Centre Hotel Grand Ballroom.
